



## How **You** Can Act for Climate Justice:

**Advocate:** Reach out to local and national **leaders** and media *every* chance you get to demand urgent action. Support the policy work of the ELCA by sending a clear message from your synod to work towards climate justice as an institution ([see Sample Memorial](#) and follow steps clarified [under "Resolutions" on our site.](#))

**Model:** Ensure your **church** is using assets of land and investments as a witness in your community. Go to Buildings/Grounds ideas section in our Congregational Guide, watch the LRC YouTube playlist for the most recent ideas/resources. [Work with others and make a list with achievable goals and specific deadlines.](#)

**Practice:** Be prayerful in how **you** consume, invest, and relate with your neighbors and nature. Many free tools which teach you about the impact of daily choices and ways to cooperate with others can be found on [our site under Personal Discipleship](#). Challenge yourself to a "Creation Tithe":
